

The Chem HelpDesk was established as a joint initiative between the World Health Organization Regional Office for South East Asia (WHO/SEARO) and the Chulabhorn Research Institute (CRI) through the International Centre for Environmental Health and Toxicology (ICEHT) in Bangkok, Thailand.


The aims of the Chem HelpDesk are to address the issue of the widening gap in the field of chemical safety between developed and developing countries, and to empower countries in the South East Asian Region to manage the import, manufacture and processing, storage, distribution, transport, use, recycling and disposal of chemicals.
